**STEEL PRODUCTION**

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of steel production in the country during each of the last three years and the current year;
- (b) whether the steel is being imported despite its sufficient production in the country;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor during the said period; and
- (d) the steps being taken by the Government to enhance the domestic production of steel?

**ANSWER**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF STEEL AND MINES (SHRI VISHNU DEO SAI)

- (a) The details of steel production in the country during each of the last three years and the current year (during April - December) are given in the table below:-

Year	Crude steel Production (in million tonnes)
2011-12	74.29
2012-13	78.42
2013-14	81.69
2014-15* April-December	62.39

- (b)&(c): Yes, Madam. Steel is being imported in the country based on factors like domestic demand and supply conditions, and prices (domestic and import price) of the item concerned. Data on imports during each of the last three years and current year (April - December) is given in the table below:-

Year	Total Finished Steel (in million tonnes)
	Import
2011-12	6.86
2012-13	7.92
2013-14	5.45
2014-15* April-December	6.49
