SKILL TRAINING CENTRES UNDER MINISTRY OF STEEL

68. SHRI RAMDAS C. TADAS:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any decision to impart skill training under the Ministry of Steel through the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the number of unemployed people who have been trained by the said Centres during the last two years;
- (c) whether the training is being imparted in Maharashtra also by the Ministry;
- (d) if so, the names of the Institutions which have been granted approval to establish the training centres; and
- (e) if not, whether the said centres are likely to be established in the future?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STEEL

(SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) There are three training Institutes namely, National Institute of Secondary Steel Technology (NISST) (headquartered at Mandi Gobindgarh with regional centres at Kolkata and Nagpur); Institute for Steel Development and Growth (INSDAG) at Kolkata and Biju Patnaik National Steel Institute (BPNSI) at Puri for imparting technical training to manpower employed in secondary steel sector. Further, individual CPSEs under Ministry of Steel impart training to their employees and apprentices.

(b) The details of the training imparted by these Institutes and CPSEs under the Ministry of Steel during 2019-20 are as following:-
