PRIVATISATION OF STEEL PSUs

1120. SHRI RIPUN BORA:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government proposes to privatise Steel PSUs of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether it is also a fact that Government has decided to close down Alloy Steel Plant, Salem Steel Plant, Visvesvaraya Iron and Steel Plant (VISP); and
- (d) the reasons for sale and/or disinvestment and thus call of global tender and its reaction on the strategic sale plan thereof?

ANSWER

- (a)&(b): The Government has approved on 27th October, 2016 that Visvesvaraya Iron & Steel Plant (Bhadrawati), Salem Steel Plant (Salem) & Alloy Steel Plant (Durgapur) units of Steel Authority India Limited (SAIL) be disinvested to a strategic buyer identity through 2-stage auction process.
- (c) No, Sir.
- (d) The main reason for disinvestment of these three units of SAIL is that, they are making losses consistently year after year. Preliminary Information Memorandum (PIM)/Expression of Interest (EoI) request was issued on 4th July, 2019 & the bids received in this regards are under evaluation.
