- (a) whether Government has any plans in encouraging "Steel plants" of Public Sector unit categories to improve its infrastructure and, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether any technical assistance has been initiated through overseas steel giants to develop country's PSUs and, if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the public sector units producing high graded steel compared with private players are provided immense financial provisions and, if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) whether there was any extra effort taken to promote the supply side of the business, especially in protecting PSU and, if so, the details thereof?
