DECLINE OF EXPORT OF FINISHED STEEL

- (a) the present status of finished steel exports as compared to imports, the details thereof;
- (b) whether it is a fact that the country's exports of finished steel are presently falling, if so, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) what action Government has initiated to reverse this trend with any new policies, if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The present status of finished steel exports as compared to imports are as under:-

Year / Period	Export	Import	Net Trade
2018-19	6.36	7.84	- 1.48
April-October, 2018-19	3.83	4.68	- 0.85
April-October, 2019-20	4.89	4.65	0.24

- (b)&(c): No, Sir. The export of finished steel has increased during April-October, 2019-20 as compared to same period during last financial year and we are net exporters during this period.
