**CORRUPTION CASES IN SAIL**

463. DR. VIKAS MAHATME:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether certain cases of corruption in Steel Authority of India Limited (SAIL) and its ancillary companies have come to the notice of Government;
- (b) if so, details thereof during the last three years;
- (c) whether Government has ordered an enquiry on the said corruption cases; and
- (d) if so, the action taken by Government on the basis of the enquiry report on guilty persons?

**ANSWER**

(a)to(d): During 2014, 2015 and 2016 i.e., last three years, 53 complaints have been received by the Government from different sources on various allegations pertaining to Steel Authority of India Ltd. (SAIL), out of which action on 49 complaints have been completed. Disciplinary action is taken by the concerned disciplinary authority based on the investigation/enquiry in the cases.
