BOOSTING STEEL PRODUCTION IN THE COUNTRY

475. SHRI C.M. RAMESH:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of steel production in the country during the last three years;
- (b) whether due to shortfall in the production of steel, exports have been reduced which resulted in revenue loss, if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether Government has taken any initiative to boost the steel production in the country, if so, the details thereof?

(a)&(b): Data on production of crude steel in India during last three years i.e. 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19 is given below:-

There is no shortfall in Production of Crude steel.

(c) Steel industry is a de-regulated sector, Indian steel companies take their own decisions based on commercial and market dynamics. Government has brought National Steel Policy (NSP), 2017, Domestically Manufactured Iron & Steel Products (DMI&SP) Policy, Steel Scrap Policy which have encouraged domestic steel usage in Government procurement and also notified Quality Control Orders to stop import of substandard steel into the country. Similarly, Anti Dumping Duties and Countervailing Duties have also been imposed to curb unfair trade practices in steel import.
