ESTABLISHMENT OF STEEL PLANT AT BAYYARAM

631. SHRI DHARMAPURI SRINIVAS:

Will the Minister of STEEL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has received any fresh request from Government of Telangana requesting to expedite setting up of steel plant at Bayyaram in Telangana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the reasons for the delay;
- (d) the hindrances being faced by Government in its establishment, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps being taken by Government in augmenting the execution of the work at the earliest?

ANSWER

(a)to(e): In terms of the Thirteenth Schedule of the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014, Steel Authority of India Ltd. (SAIL) was to examine the feasibility of establishing an integrated steel plant in YSR Kadapa District of Andhra Pradesh. As per the feasibility report submitted by SAIL on 02.12.2014, the setting up of steel plant is prima facie not financially viable.

Subsequently, a Task Force has been constituted on 19.10.2016 comprising of representatives from the Central and concerned State Governments, SAIL, RINL, NMDC Ltd., MECON Ltd. and MSTC Ltd. to suggest a road map for setting up of Steel Plants in Telangana.
